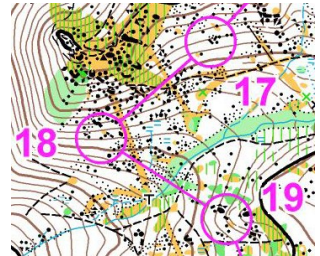

Terrain (Long Distance and Relay):



The terrain lies at 450 to 600 metres above sea level and consists mainly of coniferous forest. There are stones and cliffs, the runnability is mainly good. The extraordinary finish area is located in a quarry.



Accommodation:

The teams will be accommodated in different youth hostels in the village of Torfhaus, 8 km south of Bad Harzburg city and 5 km south of the Event centre. As space is limited late entries may have to be placed a bit further away.

Venue:

Bad Harzburg/Germany at the northern edge of the Harz mountains. Easy to reach and right in the middle of Europe.
