Friday, October 9th: Sprint

### **Terrain:**

Urban terrain with parks at Sprint. For Long Distance and Relay the terrain lies at 450 to 600 metres above sea level and consists mainly of coniferous

forest. There are interesting stones and cliffs, the runnability is mainly good. The extraordinary finish area is located at a quarry.

### Venue:

Bad Harzburg/Germany at the northern edge of the Harz mountains. Easy to reach and right in the middle of Europe.
